Dr. Daniel J. Hall was appointed Director of Choirs at Wyoming Seminary in 2022. He has served as Director of Choral Activities at Lycoming College, Ohio University, and West Texas A&M University. Additional conductorships have included the Williamsport Chamber Choir and Orchestra (PA) and the Civic Chorale of Greater Miami (FL). In addition to his choral responsibilities, Dr. Hall has taught a wide variety of graduate and undergraduate music courses and participated in the performance and production of various theatrical productions. Throughout his career he has created and overseen choral festivals, camps, and recruiting events.

Ensembles under Dr. Hall's direction have performed in prestigious venues throughout much of Europe and the United States. He has conducted choirs in guest appearances with groups such as The Rolling Stones, The Chieftains, and The Canadian Brass. In 2014, he was one of ten full conductors chosen to attend the International Chamber Choral Conducting Workshop in Sarteano, Italy, and in 2015, he was selected to be a full conductor for the Westminster Choir College Conducting Institute at Oxford.

Dr. Hall is an actively commissioned composer and arranger whose works have been heard in venues such as Carnegie Hall, Lincoln Center, and Kennedy Center, with performances as far away as Venezuela, Taiwan, New Zealand, and Ireland. His music has been widely featured at national, regional, and state festivals and professional conventions. In recent years, his works have been performed by all-state festival choruses in Alabama, Arizona, Florida, Kentucky, Minnesota, New Hampshire, New Jersey, New Mexico, New York, Texas, and Colorado. His scores are published with Walton Music, Colla Voce Press, Pavane Music, and Santa Barbara Publishing. Dr. Hall holds degrees from Frost School of Music at the University of Miami (DMA), Brigham Young University (MM), and Weber State University (BA).
